## Breathe Project Applauds President Biden's Commitments at Climate Summit

Pittsburgh, Pa. – The Breathe Project expresses its strong support for President Biden's leadership at the Climate Summit he is convening today, Earth Day 2021, at the White House. The planned announcement of pledging to cut the U.S.'s output of climate-changing pollution by 50% below 2005 levels by the year 2030 will send a clear signal to both the market and policymakers about creating a future in the best interest of all of us.

Regional leaders in Southwestern Pennsylvania should recognize the importance of choosing health and innovation in meeting these goals as the bedrock of our region's economy.
