Learn about Pittsburgh's air quality this summer from the source that knows all – a giant nose that children (and adults) can pick to glean more about the science behind why Pittsburgh has some of the worst air quality in the nation.

GASP for Clean Air! Sources, Symptoms, and Solutions is a family-friendly exhibit hosted by the Group Against Smog and Pollution (GASP) at Assemble, 4824 Penn Ave. in Garfield, on Aug. 4th during Unblurred: First Fridays, and August 14th and 21st from 6-8pm.

The exhibit will be on display for a month with special events during the week of *Unblurred*. The interactive exhibits like Pick the Giant Nose, a Window into Air Pollution and an environmental justice display will encourage audiences to contemplate a variety of issues surrounding air quality, such as environmental justice, human health, and the consequences of living in an increasingly industrialized world. Children can play with a plush organ that will teach them how pollution affects various parts of the body.
