Thank you for attending today's screening of Single Use Planet, a documentary that explores the dangers of single-use plastics, their connection to fracking and the environmental and health impacts of the Shell Petrochemical Plant in Beaver County. The Shell Plastic Plant in Beaver PA, like all petrochemical plants, "crack" ethane into polyethylene (plastic) pellets called "nurdles" that will be used to manufacture plastic and chemical products. The plant will produce an estimated 1.6 million tons of plastic pellets and emit 522 tons per year of volatile organic compounds and 30.5 million tons of hazardous air pollutants. Since the Shell petrochemicals complex was first announced in 2012, Beaver County has fallen behind Pennsylvania & the nation in nearly every indicator of economic prosperity.
